## School Tour Presentation

Prepare to lead a complete school tour we have studied. This is a tour of your choice (but not Early America since it is not running now). You will present the entire school tour to a group of at least 3 DOTS during the summer. Choose from *Math through Art*, *Science through Art*, *Animals in Art*, *Let's Sketch*, *European and American Masterpieces*, *Asian Masterpieces*, *Literature through Art* or *Elements of Art*. Schedule a time with your fellow DOTS to present and let Jan know. Mondays are always good since we rarely have tours that day, but you may pick another day if Jan clears it with her schedule. Your DOT students will complete an evaluation form after the tour. These forms will be turned into Betsy for review.

Due Date: August 25 before fall class begins

Tour Length: 1.5 hours

Audience: K-6 or as appropriate for the tour

The group tour should include:

- Introduction and rules
- Questions and discussion focused on work of art
- Required activities
- Looking activities
- Transitions from one gallery to the next
- Conclusion

Keep it **simple**, (remember your audience) **creative**, and **fun!**  
Remember, kids can get rowdy if they are bored. No notes allowed!
