Tutor Educated the children of the household where there were no schools.

Carpenter Constructed houses and barns in the area.

Schoolmaster set up a school for the children in the area or for the servants of the wealthy.

Land Surveyor Mapped the land of the new world.

Clerk and bookkeeper Kept the accounting books for his master who owned a shop.

Barber Ran a barbershop in the town.

Ship-carpenter and caulker Built ships and caulked the seams.

Tailor/Seamstress Make clothes for the owner and townspeople.

Shoemaker Made shoes for the people in the area.
