- Paint chips for Monet

- Ben day boxes and laminated sheets for project

Med courtyard - Set up solar project from cart:

- Trays with water, solar paper envelope, plastic box of objects for the solar printing, hang clothesline, grease pencils, rag to clean the plexi, plexi glass rectangles, clipboards, clothespins

Set up Title 1 snacks on table: for Title 1 schools only

Pitchers of water, cookies, cups, wipes (Ed staff will set up for the first group.)

Gallery 17 - Ed staff will set up projector

- Tour bag with samples of clay process - mud, leather hard, bisque, low fired and glazed, fired and glazed, cones

- Set up glass objects box in Kinau hallway:: lightening struck sand, blown glass bubbles and glob

Gallery 13 - Ed staff will set out armature

- Tour bag - simple machine photo, mobile pieces, bags and tesserae for making a mobile
