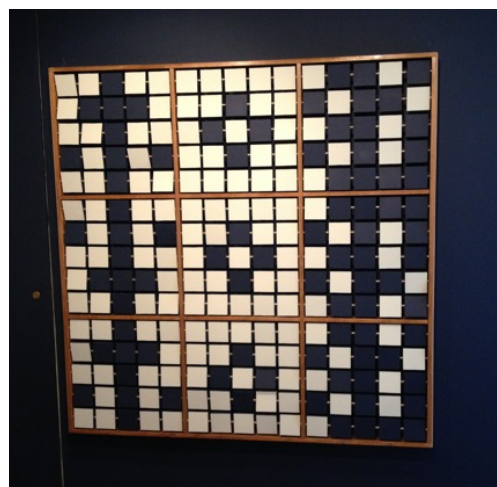


## Textile 01010110

Here is a wonderful write up by DEB NEHMAD of the activity in the textile gallery.

The top piece is a repetitive pattern. I had one person design an asymmetrical pattern in the middle grid and then had 8 other students copy it. I then took a photo and showed it to them. For some reason, making it smaller helps define the pattern more. The second piece is a mirror pattern. In this case, I had three different students design three different asymmetrical patterns in the middle row and then mirrored these patterns above and below.



These pieces were done today. The top piece is repetitive and done the same way.

The bottom is a mirror pattern, but in this case, I repeated the pattern in the middle row and then mirrored top and bottom.
